**Re: Failure to sanction killers of Jamal Khashoggi.** Proposed script/email:

*"I am profoundly dissatisfied that Pres. Biden has disregarded his campaign promise to hold Saudi Arabia's Crown Prince accountable for the murder of journalist Jamal Khashoggi. Letting him off with no personal consequences signals to other tyrants they may murder journalists without personal consequence. Pres. Biden should ensure that he never personally meets directly with the Crown Prince, that the Crown Prince is not invited to any G20 summits, and does not set foot in the United States."*

### **For Senators Kelly and Sinema:**

Please contact both Senators AGAIN and ask them to co-sponsor the "For the People Act" and the "John Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act" and let them know their efforts are almost meaningless without their support for the removal of the filibuster.

Sample voice mail or email: ***"My name is XXXX and I live in XXXXX, Arizona. Arizona's legislators have currently introduced dozens of laws that would suppress voter participation, in particular harming minorities. We urgently need your co sponsorship of the For the People Act (S1) and the John Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act" in the Senate.***

***I urge you to support removing the filibuster, or alternatively taking a public lead in finding 10 Republican senators to support these bills, so that we can have some hope of protecting our voting rights.***

### ***George Floyd Justice in Policing Act.***

***"My name is XXXX and I live in XXXXX, Arizona. The House has just passed the George Floyd Justice in Policing Act. I strongly urge you to co sponsor the Act in the Senate. It offers common sense policing reforms such as creating a national registry for officers fired for using excessive force, mandates the use of body cameras, bans certain choke holds, and would prohibit profiling based on race or religion.***
